

Bani Israeel: Lessons from History - 2 Corruptions and 2 Punishments

5000 BC Migration from Arabian Peninsula to Babylonia (Iraq) and Palestine

2000 BC Ibraheem born in Babylonia - Urr - Moved to Palestine and then Makkah - Built the Kabah - Returned to Palestine and passed away here.

Ibraheem

Ishaq
Yaqoob (Israeel)
12 sons (Bani Israeel)
Yusuf

Ismaeel
Prophet Muhammad saw

Age of 17 came to Egypt
Age of 30 became the minister
11 brothers & Yaqoob (Qanaan in Palestine -> Egypt)
Lived in Egypt for 430 years

Musa

Crossed Red Sea and came to Sinai Peninsula - Bani Israeel refused to do jihad and were left in the Peninsula for 40 years

1050 BC

Yusha ibn Noon

Crossed River Jordan - Invaded the first town Jerico in Palestine (8000 yr old town)
King Samueel - Appointed Talut - His army - Warrior Daud fought Goliath

Approx 300 years

Daud

Sulaiman

Both ruled for 70 years - Built the masjid (haikal e Sulaiman: 20 x 30 metres)
Tabut containing the Tablets, staff and clothes (Barakah)
After the death of Sulaiman

Rahbaar's Rule

Kingdom of Judia
(Tribes of Yusuf & Benyamen)
(lasted 467 years)
Capital - Jerusalem

Jerusalem known in the time of
Ibraheem as Uur Saalim - Malik Saadiq

Kingdom of Israeel
(Other 10 Tribes)
(lasted 298 years)
Capital - Shakeem/Nebulus

**Golden
Period
70 Years**

Narrated Abdullah ibn Amr ibn al'Aas (Tirmidhi)

The Prophet salAllahuAlaihiwasallam said:

"Whatever befell the Bani Israeel will definitely befall by ummah, just as a shoe resembles another shoe"

1st Corruption and Punishment

The two kingdoms especially the Kingdom of Israel started to spread corruption i.e. idol worship and left the teachings of the prophet Ibraheem etc

586 BC

Nebuchadnezzar - King of Babylonia
Invaded Palestine killed approx. 600,000 - Destroyed and devastated the temple completely even its foundations
Took approx. 600,000 Jewish captives to Babylonia (Iraq) (50-70 years)
Colony on the bank of the River Euphrate - Telaviv

450 BC

Cyrus (Dhul Qarnayn) - King of Persia (Iran)
Invaded Babylonia and brought the Jews back to Palestine
Started to rebuild the temple (took 22 years)
Prophet Uzayr - Dictated Torah from memory
Another chance - If you do good
{Persians stayed for 206 years}

Alexander expelled the Persians - Greek remained for 166 years

170 - 67 BC

Jews rebelled - **Mokabi** Rabbi and his 5 sons and popular support (influence by Uzayr teaching - **Mokabi Kingdom**)
Lasted 93 years during which they used Shikel as the money which is also being used today

2nd Corruption and Punishment

1 CE

King Herod (Jewish, but not Israeelee - Adoomee from the brother of Yaqoob, Eesuu)
He contributed to the construction of the temple
He ordered every child in Bethlehem to be killed
1 year before his death Jesus was born
Jesus entered Bethlehem at age of 8, 20 and 30

Pontios Pilatus the Governor of Jerusalem
Rabbis disliked Jesus so they were against Jesus
Committee of Sendreem - 70 scholars - Ruled - Jesus giving life on the sabbath, stopped from stoning - Passed judgement against Jesus - The Way of Pains - Cathedral of Qiyamah
Killed Zakariyah and Yahya before

70 CE

2nd Punishment came
Titus 70AD Roman invaded Palestine, killed 133,000 people in one day, took 67,000 as slaves, destroyed the temple completely - Wailing wall - this was the part built by Herod not Sulaiman.

135 CE

135 AD **Hedrion** a Roman emperor expelled them all, rebuilt the city but instead of calling it Jerusalem he named it Eeliya -> **Diaspora**

325 CE

325 AD Roman Emperor **Constantine** became Christian, Queen Helen also became Christian and came to Jerusalem - 326AD Cross was discovered - Cathedral built

570 CE

Birth of the **Last Prophet Muhammad** salAllahuhiwasallam

636 CE

16AH 636AD **Umar** conquered Jerusalem
Till the previous century - Fall of the Ottoman Empire 1926
